CHAPTER 6: GENERAL REGULATIONS

ORDINANCE 62 LICENSES AND PERMITS

Section 62.01: DELINQUENT PERSON. The City shall not issue or renew any license or permit to any Person if the Person is delinquent in paying taxes, assessments, or other City financial claims at the time of application, issuance or renewal.

Section 62.02: DELINQUENT PREMISES. The City shall not issue or renew any license or permit regarding the conduct of a business or other activity upon any premises within the City if there are delinquent taxes, assessments or other financial claims regarding the premises at the time of application, issuance or renewal.

Section 62.03: EXCEPTIONS. The City may grant or renew a license or permit despite delinquent taxes, assessments or other financial claims if the applicant arranges to pay the delinquencies or demonstrates good cause for issuing the license or permit despite the delinquencies.

Section 62.04: HEARING. Any Person aggrieved by the City's action or inaction regarding a license or permit application may make a written request for a hearing before the City Council. The aggrieved Person and the City may present evidence and cross-examine witnesses at the hearing to determine the validity of the City's financial claim and reasonableness of the City's action regarding the license or permit application.

Section 62.05: SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION. Unless this Code or State law provides otherwise, the City Council may suspend or revoke any license or permit for violating any Code provision, any State or federal law or regulation or any license or permit condition or requirement following notice and a hearing as the law requires.
